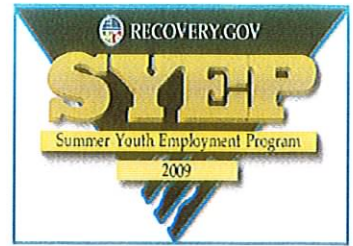




# Summer Youth Work Experience (SYWE)



## Money in Your Pocket.... Change in Your Life

### Tier I:

The JobsPlus Summer Youth Work Experience is a four week program designed for youth between the ages of 14 to 17. Through performance incentives, participants may earn up to \$550 for completing the program and gain valuable employment experience increasing their chances to have a successful working career.

*Crestview—June 29th*

*Walton County—July 6th*

\*To be certified as eligible for SYWE, the youth must meet the following WIA

Youth eligibility criteria: An individual who –

- a) Is not less than age 14 and not more than age 24; AND
- b) Is a low-income individual as defined, AND
- c) Is an individual who has one or more of the following barriers:
  - Deficient in basic literacy skills;
  - High school dropout;
  - Homeless, a runaway, or a foster child;
  - Pregnant or a parent;
  - An offender;
  - An individual who requires additional assistance to complete an Education program, or to secure and hold employment.
